# Privacy Policy

1. This privacy policy includes the "duty to inform when collecting personal data from the data subject" in accordance with Art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (DS-GVO).
2. Responsible body: Beyond Borders e.V, Weißenburger Str. 10, 22049 Hamburg

3. When a member joins, the association records the following personal data:
  - Name
  - Address
  - Date of birth
  - e-mail address
4. This information is stored in the association's own EDP system. The personal data will be protected by appropriate technical and organizational measures against the knowledge of third parties. Third parties are granted access if they - a. are members of the association and - b. the knowledge of the data is necessary for the performance of a task fulfilling the purpose of the statutes. The names of these persons are collected in the directory "Access to personal data". Information about this can be requested from the board.
5. According to Art. 6, Para. 1, lit. b) DSGVO, the processing of personal data is lawful if it is necessary for the fulfillment of a contractual relationship - in this case: Membership in the association - are required.
6. For further personal data and for such data that is to be published in the association's publications and online media, a written declaration of consent from the member is required in compliance with Art. 7 DSGVO. For this purpose, a corresponding form of the association is to be signed by the member. The decision to collect further personal data and its publication is made voluntarily by the member. The member can revoke the consent at any time without adverse consequences with effect for the future in text form to the board of the association (contact see point 2).
7. When leaving the association, the personal data of the member will be deleted from the member data management. Personal data relating to the cash administration will be stored in accordance with the provisions of tax law for up to ten years from the written confirmation of resignation by the Board. They will be blocked.
8. The member has the right to information of the association about his stored data as well as their correction and deletion (unless Art. 6, para. 1, lit b) or lit. f) DSGVO is concerned). This also refers to a restriction of data processing or an objection to data transfer. A corresponding request must be made in text form to the board.
